Grapevine Garden Club Kids Art Contest Rules

1. Students in grades K-1 are eligible to enter the contest as Sprouting Artists, in grades 2-3 as Budding Artists, and grades 4-5 as Blooming Artists.
2. Entries should be completed by students with minimal parental assistance.
3. To qualify for judging the student must follow these rules:
  - a) Entries must be no larger than 18’x24’.
  - b) The contest theme “Adventures of the Monarch” must be written on the front of the entry.
  - c) No computer or electronically-generated artwork.
  - d) Entries must be flat – no 3D artwork.
  - e) Use crayons, markers, paints, water color, etc.
  - f) Poster board and thin, flat canvases are allowed. Artwork on lightweight paper needs to be mounted on a heavier paper such as poster board.
4. Entries will be judged for originality, design, slogan, artwork and overall effectiveness of the message.
5. Entries should be given to the student’s GCISD Art Teacher by the morning of Wednesday, October 17<sup>th</sup>.
6. Entries will be displayed in the Grapevine Botanical Gardens, Pewitt Educational Pavilion on Saturday, October 20 from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. at Butterfly Flutterby. Contest winners will be announced after the Butterfly Flutterby parade between 12 – 1 p.m.
7. Winning entries for each grade level will be awarded a First, Second, Third or Honorable Mention ribbon. One Grand Prize Winner in each group – Sprouting Artists, Budding Artists and Blooming Artists – will each be awarded a \$25 gift card.
8. All artwork will be returned to the student. All entries may be used for future publications, exhibits and social media at the discretion of the Grapevine Garden Club and the Grapevine Convention and Visitors Bureau.
